June 11	Saturday	Depart U.S.	Flight	Depart the US on your overnight flight to Amsterdam. Please check your flight itinerary for flight details.	Flight
12	Sunday	Amsterdam / Arrive Arusha	Mountain Village Lodge	Connect in Amsterdam with your flight to Kilimanjaro Airport, arriving late this evening. You will be met by Thomson Safaris staff and transferred to your lodge in Arusha.	Flight
13	Monday	Arusha / Tarangire National Park	Tarangire Safari Lodge	<p>You will awake to a new world this morning. Leaving your room and walking through the lush garden is a gentle reminder that you are now in Africa. Exotic birdcalls fill the air and hints of freshly brewed Tanzanian coffee mean that breakfast awaits you.</p> <p>After a briefing with your guide, you will leave Arusha by Land Rover, crossing the Maasai Steppe on your way to Tarangire National Park, Tanzania's fourth largest and one of its most diverse. Stop at the picturesque park gate to enjoy a picnic lunch and afterwards you'll begin viewing animals in the park.</p> <p>Zebra, wildebeest, bushbuck, dik-dik and guinea fowl regularly cross your path, unbothered by your benign presence and going about their daily routines. You'll meander along bush tracks and explore the Tarangire River's twists and turns, finding elephant drinking and playing in the refreshing waters. Late this afternoon you'll arrive at your permanent-tented-camp where you can settle in and relax before dinner and your first night in the bush.</p>	B, BL, D

14	Tuesday	Tarangire National Park	Tarangire Safari Lodge	<p>Today is your first morning in the bush. The sounds of buff-bellied warblers and African doves provide your gentle wake-up call. A hearty breakfast prepared by experienced chefs wakens your senses and prepares you for a full day of wildlife viewing. Take a picnic lunch with you to maximize your time in the bush.</p> <p>The Tarangire River, which bisects the park, provides a year-round source of food and water for the resident and migratory wildlife populations, but you will also explore miombo woodland and short grass plains in search of leopard, lion, reedbuck, gerenuk, Grant's gazelle and more. The large elephant populations in Tarangire are quite notable, but birders will be especially impressed by the variety of avian species, which number over 500.</p> <p>After a full day in the bush, you will enjoy relaxing back at camp with a cool drink while you watch the stunning sunset over the Tarangire River Valley. Enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers.</p>	B, BL, D

15	Wednesday	Tarangire / Ngorongoro Conservation Area	Thomson Ngorongoro Nyumba - NMS	<p>After breakfast you'll depart the park and cross the Maasai Steppe on your way to Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Soon, the impressive Great Rift Valley Escarpment will come into view – a 2,000 foot high wall that rises up out of the flat plains. Head up the winding, switch-back road, through bucolic rural farm land as you approach Gibbs Farm, where you will stop for lunch. Then continue up to Ngorongoro Crater itself. Arrive at your Thomson Nyumba camp and settle in before visiting the nearby Maasai boma of Irkeepusi. Here you'll meet friends of Thomson Safaris who will give you a window into their day-to-day lives. Maasai are pastoralists who tend sheep and goats, and their most prized possessions: cattle.</p> <p>Return to your Nyumba in time for a delicious dinner this evening. Prepare for a full day of wildlife viewing before heading to bed tonight. Please note, at this elevation the nighttime temperatures are cool year-round (40-55 degrees F or 4-10 degrees C). Make sure to bring warm layers with you on safari.</p> <p><i>A private tech-tent for guests on the Photo Safari will be available at Thomson Nyumbas each evening. Guests can use this to charge batteries for electronic equipment like laptops. The tech-tent will be available until 9pm each day; it will be shut off after that time to preserve the pristine ambiance of the wilderness at night.</i></p>	B, L, D

16	Thursday	Ngorongoro Crater	Thomson Ngorongoro Nyumba - NMS	<p>Rise for a hearty camp breakfast before you spend a full day exploring the crater floor. The area is world-renowned in its reputation and very small in its scale, so you will see other safari goers. Don't let that distract you from the beauty of the place or from the fact that this remains one of the only places on earth where you may see all of the Big Five at once: Lion, Leopard, Bull Elephant, African Buffalo and Black Rhino. To maximize your time on the crater floor you will enjoy a picnic lunch at a scenic picnic spot.</p> <p>Your journey will take you throughout this tremendous landscape that is constantly changing as animals move to and fro in search of pasture, water or easy prey. Before sunset, it is time to depart this Garden of Eden for the comfort of your Nyumba, which is nestled in the lush forested landscape that is so typical of the fertile Ngorongoro region. Relax with some palate teasers before your evening meal. Sleep well tonight, before a busy day tomorrow.</p> <p><i>Tech-tent available beginning late this afternoon until 9pm.</i></p>	B, BL, D

17	Friday	Ngorongoro Conservation Area / Serengeti National Park via Olduvai Gorge	Thomson Serengeti Nyumba - Central - SMM	<p>Rise early today. As the cool, fresh air fills your lungs you'll feel invigorated and rejuvenated, ready for another great day on safari. Pack up your bags and depart camp after your early breakfast. You'll have one more opportunity for photographing wildlife on the crater floor as you descend from the eastern rim and cross westward through this rich ecosystem. The crater provides year-round sources of food and water for the resident animal populations. You may see lion, hyena, warthog and zebra as well as some of the largest bull elephants on the planet. Birders will be also be impressed by the hundreds of avian species in this area</p> <p>Later this morning you'll drive through Ngorongoro Conservation Area before making a stop at Olduvai Gorge. Here you have a chance to visit the museum learn about some of the incredible finds of Drs. Louis and Mary Leakey.</p> <p>Enter the Serengeti later this morning. The plains seem endless as you meander through the wildlife-rich Seronera River Valley. Settle in to your private Nyumbas later this afternoon and enjoy another wonderful dinner. Gather around the campfire to enjoy a brilliant spectacle of stars and a relaxing drink.</p> <p><i>Tech-tent available beginning late this afternoon until 9pm.</i></p>	B, BL, D

18	Saturday	Serengeti National Park	Thomson Serengeti Nyumba - Central - SMM	<p>Today you have the option of joining a Serengeti balloon safari (additional fee and advance reservations required-if needed, the back up ballooning day would be tomorrow morning). The experience begins with an early rise (approx 4am) and pre-dawn drive to the balloon launch site, where you will be given a balloon briefing prior to take-off. As the sun rises, you lift gently off the ground, enjoying a bird's eye perspective as you skim over the tops of acacia trees, meander over the Seronera River and finally touch down. You'll be greeted with a champagne toast and treated to a full English breakfast.</p> <p>For those who do not join the balloon ride this morning you'll awaken instead to the calls of the African dove or superb starling. From the comfort of your Nyumba you'll smell the luscious scents of hot tea and fresh coffee beckoning you to greet the dawn; the majesty of the Serengeti awaits! As you sit comfortably on your verandah, sipping hot drinks and watching the day break, you may even spot giraffe or zebra grazing in the distance. After breakfast at your Nyumba you begin your quest to discover abundant and fascinating animal behavior in the park.</p> <p>Later this morning you'll all regroup to continue your wildlife viewing for the rest of the day, stopping to enjoy a picnic lunch at your leisure.</p> <p>Upon your return to camp this afternoon you can relax in the tranquility of your Nyumba as you reflect on today's activities; your exploration of the heart of the park has been both informative and adventurous and you'll relish each moment in your unique surrounds. Few travelers ever have the privilege of seeing, "the world as it was in the beginning." Under your dining tent, hot soup, fresh bread, entrees and a scrumptious dessert await your evening indulgence. Retire to your comfortable camp beds after a full and satisfying day.</p> <p><i>Tech-tent available beginning late this afternoon until 9pm.</i></p>	B, BL, D

19	Sunday	Serengeti National Park	Thomson Serengeti Nyumba - Central - SMM	<p>Rise early for a quick breakfast and hit the road by 6am. Photograph in the pristine, first light of day before returning to camp for an early lunch followed by some time to discuss photography, review the new additions to your portfolio, or rest before continuing with more wildlife viewing and photography.</p> <p>Hop in your trusty Land Rovers mid afternoon. You'll want to roll down the windows or stand up to take advantage of the customized roof hatch. Feel the fresh air rush past as you navigate winding paths and secret trails in your pursuit of interesting wildlife sightings. With this perspective, you have unhindered 360° views, and the possibilities for what lies in store are endless!</p> <p>After returning to camp late in the day you can have a drink, appetizers or a refreshing shower before sitting down for dinner with your group tonight. As you gaze out at the majestic Serengeti Plains you will feel privilege of being one of the few people in who can say that you saw, "the world as it was in the beginning."</p> <p><i>Tech-tent available beginning late this afternoon until 9pm.</i></p>	B, L, D
20	Monday	Serengeti National Park	Thomson Serengeti Nyumba - Central - SMM	<p>Spend another day in the Serengeti, where the wildebeest rut is likely to be in full-swing. This is an outstanding seasonal occurrence, which few travelers have the opportunity to experience first-hand. Over 1.5 million animals will demonstrate behavior unique to their en-masse mating season. Watch males square off with one another as they vie for the best territories, and the interest of females wandering nearby.</p> <p>Return to camp this afternoon. Having experienced wonderful wildlife viewing throughout the day, dinner is sure to be a lively, engaging affair as guests swap stories about all that you've seen. Continue your conversation around the crackling campfire this evening. Fall asleep to the sounds of nearby animals tonight.</p> <p><i>Tech-tent available beginning late this afternoon until 9pm.</i></p>	B, BL, D

21	Tuesday	Serengeti National Park	Thomson Serengeti Nyumba - Central - SMM	<p>Rise early for a quick breakfast and hit the road by 6am. Spanning nearly 6,000 square miles, the Serengeti has even more to offer you today! Photograph in the pristine, first light of day before returning to camp for an early lunch. Have a brief rest and explore more of the Seronera River Valley this afternoon. Here you may find grazing animals like wildebeest tentatively drinking from the muddy banks...meanwhile crocodiles are lurking in nearby, just under the surface of the murky water, waiting for the perfect opportunity to grab a meal on the run.</p> <p>This evening when you return to camp you can indulge in a few tasty snacks while watching the brilliant equatorial sun dip below the horizon. After a from-scratch dinner of home-made soup and fresh-baked bread, chef-prepared entrees and dessert, you will have time to relax with friends by the campfire one last time. On this last night in the bush, reflect on all that you've experienced. Precious memories like this are to be celebrated in the moment and savored for a lifetime.</p> <p><i>Tech-tent available beginning late this afternoon until 9pm.</i></p>	B, BL, D
22	Wednesday	Serengeti / Arusha / Depart	Kia Lodge - Day Room	<p>Later this morning take a Regional flight* to Arusha (50 lb baggage limit). As you visually retrace your route from above, note the change in landscape from the flat plains of the Serengeti to the verdant, rolling hills of the Ngorongoro Highlands. Touch down at Arusha Airport in time for a bit of shopping and a farewell lunch at Riverhouse with your new safari friends. Day rooms are provided for you to rest and relax before checking in for your departing KLM flight to Amsterdam. Take dinner with you to the airport, which you can enjoy at your leisure.</p>	B, L, BD Flight
23	Thursday	Amsterdam / U.S.	Home	<p>Connect in Amsterdam and arrive in the U.S. Please check your flight itinerary for details.</p>	Flight
